## STREET CLOSURES FOR THE TASTE OF CINCINNATI

Beginning at 6:00 PM Friday, May 26, 2006 and continuing until 5:00 AM Tuesday, May 30, 2006 the following streets will be closed to all traffic for the annual "Taste of Cincinnati":

1. Central Parkway between Plum Street and Main Street. Access to Elm Street is available either at Central Parkway and Twelfth Street or by taking Central Parkway to Plum Street, to left on Court Street, to left on Elm Street, which is open through Central Parkway.
2. Race Street between Court Street and Twelfth Street.
3. Vine Street between Court Street and Twelfth Street.
4. Walnut Street between Court Street and Twelfth Street.

All parking on the above mentioned streets will be prohibited. Motorists should be aware other temporary parking restrictions may be posted.

Metro bus services will be rerouted around the closed areas. Riders should look for alternative stops.
