MuralWorks Goal

- To transform Cincinnati neighborhoods by creating inspirational works of public art that will have a lasting community impact.
- To employ Cincinnati youth in jobs which will help prepare them for future employment
- To create a sustainable mural arts program in the City of Cincinnati that will result in hundreds of murals in all of Cincinnati's 52 neighborhoods.

MuralWorks Program Year One Details

- Create 6 murals in 6 different Cincinnati neighborhoods
- Hire 80 youth apprentices, ages 14-19, to be trained as artists
- Hire 16 professional artists to manage the projects and train the youth
