Mayor Mallory to Host the Lord Mayor of Munich, Germany Cincinnati and Munich are celebrating 20 years as Sister Cities

Cincinnati – Tomorrow, Mayor Mark Mallory is welcoming Lord Mayor of Munich, Germany, Christian Ude, to Cincinnati for an official visit. 2010 is the 20th anniversary of Munich, Germany becoming Cincinnati's Sister City. Lord Mayor Ude is visiting Cincinnati on his way back to Germany, after attending the Winter Olympics in Vancouver where he was pitching Munich as a future host city for the Winter Olympics.

"I am honored to host the Lord Mayor of our Sister City, Munich in Cincinnati," Mayor Mark Mallory said. "I have been working to strengthen our relationship with Munich over the last few years. This is a great opportunity to introduce the Lord Mayor Ude to members of our community and continue building relationships that with benefit Cincinnati for years to come."

The visit by Lord Mayor Ude is the first official visit by a Mayor of one of Cincinnati's seven Sister Cities that Mayor Mallory has hosted. German businesses located in the Cincinnati region include Siemens in Norwood and Baerlocher in Carthage.
