CITY OF CINCINNATI–Winter Operations

Weather Status:

The National Weather Service is calling for occasional snow showers with areas of blowing snow tonight. Snow accumulation of 1 to 3 inches. Lows in the mid 20s. Northwest winds 10 to 15 mph with gusts to 25 mph. Chance of snow 100 percent.

Saturday...Cloudy with scattered snow showers. Highs in the mid 30s. Northwest winds around 10 mph. Chance of snow 50 percent.

Operational Status:

- Once snow started falling across the area, crews were able to treat most primary roadways and a significant portion of the residential streets.
- Within the last hour or so primary roads started to recover. Most of the 53 crews out on the road have refocused their efforts on primary roadways.
- Accumulation is continuing to respond well to treatments applied the roadways with the help of warmer pavement temperatures.
- If hitting the road early this morning, citizens should drive cautiously due to potentially hazardous driving conditions. Pay particular attention when approaching bridges, overpasses and any other elevated road surface.
