



## "I.T. VILLAGE" YOUTH LAB

*(Information Technology "IT Takes" A Village)*



The "**I.T. Village**" Youth Lab, an initiative of City Manager Milton Dohoney, is designed to help Cincinnati area youth enhance technology literacy and IT business skills. It is a partnership of the City of Cincinnati, Dell, Inc. and Uptown Consortium.

### QUALIFICATIONS

City of Cincinnati/Hamilton County student residents between grades 6 – 12 with a valid student Identification Card and/or by verifying their age and residency. Students must have a "C" average in most recent school term, maintain strong citizenship, and a recommendation letter from the applicant school or from designated organizations collecting applications for the Regional Computer Center. ***Immediate family of program partners are not eligible to participate in the program.***

### WHEN

Two sessions every Tuesday and Thursday at 3:00 pm and 4:15 pm beginning February 10<sup>th</sup>. The sessions will be held at the Uptown Village (Avondale Community Pride Center) and Downtown Village (Centennial II Plaza).

### GRADUATION

Students successfully completing the six week, twelve session program will each receive a Dell computer.

### APPLICATION

Applications are available at the Avondale Community Pride Center, Cincinnati Youth Collaborative, Uptown Consortium, and Urban League of Greater Cincinnati.

### DEADLINE

Applications for the Winter Term are due Friday, January 16th.
